At Emma Norton, we believe that housing provides the foundation for every human being to heal, recover, and build a more stable, harmonious life. Please join us in investing in this bold vision of hope and healing through our new development in Highland Bridge: Restoring Waters.

The Need... After more than 100 years of serving individuals and families, we understand what they need. We know that safe and affordable housing—sorely lacking in our community—and trauma-informed supportive services can truly transform lives. While Emma Norton Residence has served our community well for over 50 years, we recognize that our residents need more than a place to live.

The Solution... Individuals and their families need safe and quality housing coupled with supportive services to recover from trauma.

With our partners—Project for Pride in Living, UrbanWorks, and Ryan Companies—we will develop safe, transformative housing for 60 individuals and small families at Restoring Waters in Highland Bridge. We will also make needed renovations to Emma's Place in Maplewood.

With renovations to Emma's Place and the creation of Restoring Waters, we will have the room to offer a full spectrum of holistic, compassionate, and culturally specific services to foster transformation. These buildings will incorporate the key tenets of trauma-informed design: dignity and independence for residents, safety and privacy, inviting spaces, and a sense of stability and security.
